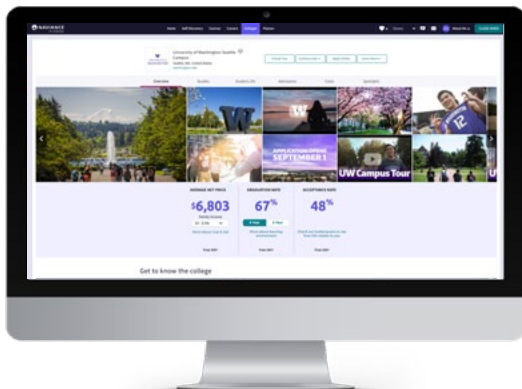
Self-Discovery

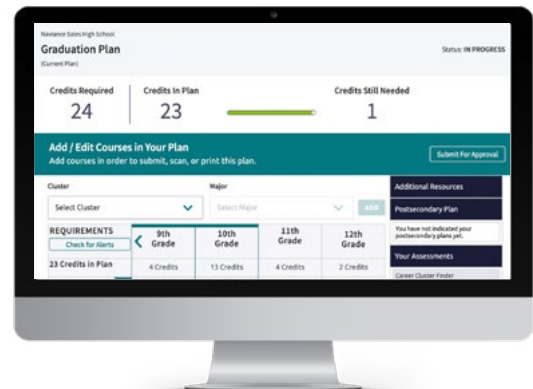
Career Planning

Course Planner

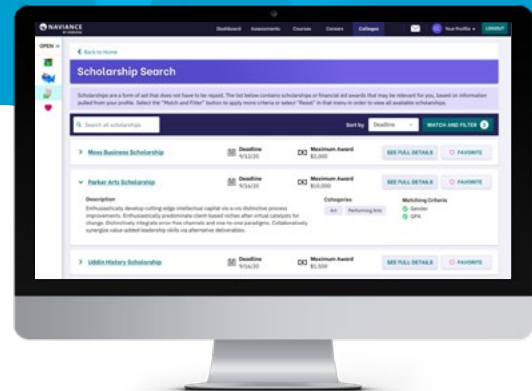

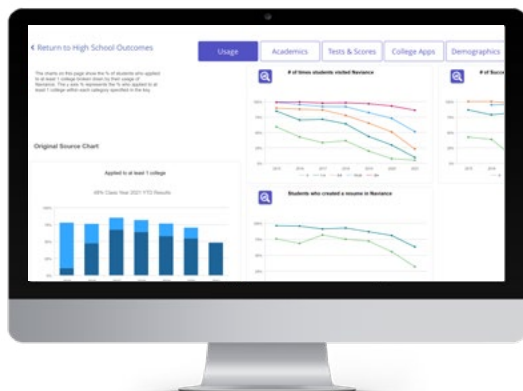
Curriculum
