### Supporting Independent Study (IS) in accordance with AB 130

AB 130's effect on independent study (IS) can be supported by Schology Learning in multiple ways:

#### Schology Learning provides tools to deliver independent study

AB 130 requires all LEAs to include a plan for offering IS to pupils affected by school closures. This requirement applies to all requests due to events that occur after September 1, 2021, and **is not limited to the 2021-22 school year.**

#### Schology Learning provides robust parent communication tools

AB 130 has a requirement that school districts and COEs notify parents and guardians of their options to enroll their pupil in in-person instruction or IS during the 2021-22 school year.

#### Schology Learning provides built-in conferencing options

AB 130 requires that, prior to signing the written agreement for IS, and at a pupil's parent's, or guardian's request, all LEAs offering IS must hold a pupil-parent-educator conference or school meeting via phone, videoconference, or in person.



### Assembly Bill 130

Signed into law on July 9, 2021, AB 130 made changes to the independent study (IS) that LEAs and COEs offer to students in California.
