



Reclaim Time For Instruction Thanks To PreMade Assessments and SEL Surveys

Thanks to pre-made items, CASEL-aligned SEL surveys, and short formative and comprehensive assessments aligned to your state standards, educators simply have more time to focus on addressing learning loss (as they are no longer required to build items and assessments from scratch).

EXAMPLE:

A teacher in Virginia has been teaching a new learning objective for the past several days. In order to monitor student progress, he delivers a pre-made short formative assessment to identify which students need additional support to become proficient on this specific skill.



Self-Discovery Reporting Simplifies Your Ability To Identify and Address Learning Loss

Staff have the ability to quickly compare student performance on local assessments, third-party assessments (state summative tests, diagnostic assessments, etc.), attendance, and behavior in order to identify the students who are most impacted by COVID-related disruptions.

EXAMPLE:

In less than five minutes, an instructional coach in Michigan builds a report that identifies all students with special needs that a) passed last year's Q3 English benchmark, b) have a D/F in English this year, and c) have 10+ absences this year—all key data points for identifying students that may be in danger of falling off track.



A More Secure Approach To Building and Sharing Centrally-Created Reports

School and district administrators can create reports centrally and share these dashboards with staff via a secure URL—which requires users to authenticate and automatically filters the report based on that specific user’s role and permissions.

EXAMPLE:

A Director of Mathematics Curriculum in California builds a single report at the beginning of the year, which she shares with math teachers throughout the district and leverages to inform staff development needs over the coming months.


